On wheel fairings, I hav'nt actually had any calls but I would like to list them if you will give me the price and other necessary information.

This year there were six Baby Ace and two Junior Aces at Rockford. Neft year I hope it will be better. I ran into Jack Rose who built the Rose Parakeet and had a nice long talk with him. I ran into many fellows who are building Aces are thinking about building, and I sold a few sets of plans.

On this trip I also went on up to Tommyhawk, Wisconsin and picked up the remains of the original D model Baby Ace. Actually I have everything except the wings and it is in good shape. The ends were knocked off of both wings in a ground look a couple of years ago. I plan to build a new set of wings for this ship this winter. It will give me a ship just exactly like the plans I am selling.

I am glad to see that you are building your original Baby Ace up. I ran into Hal Thompson of Lake Worth, Florida at the Fly-In. He was interested in your ship and has talked to you about it.
