Dear Sir:

We wish to thank you for your inquiry regarding the "CORFET-150" and we are proud to send you the three view drawings, specifications, construction details, the FAA requirements regarding homebuilt planes, and a certificate worth \$3.00 on the purchase of a set of detailed drawings.

Because of the large response to our announcement of this new Corben design, it is impossible, at this time, even to try to answer each inquiry with a personal letter; so we have gone to considerable expense to prepare our literature in booklet form. We believe that this booklet contains most of the information that a prospective builder might desire. If it doesn't, we shall be only too pleased to try to answer additional questions.

It is our utmost desire to help a builder in the construction of his plane so he will have a safe and finished-looking plane when it is completed, one which will make him proud as the builder and our company proud as the designer.

At present we supply only the detailed construction drawings; however, it is our plan to be in a position to supply a complete bill of materials in group form, semibuilt parts, some parts made up ready to assemble. It will be a matter of two or three months before we are in a position to do this; but as your name is on our mailing list, we will send you details and prices when available.

If materials are purchased on the open market, the cost of building the CORFET--less engine, propeller, and instruments--will run approximately \$950.00. We have several quotations out at present for purchases of materials in large quantities; we believe that we will be able to supply a complete bill of materials at quite a saving over the above price.

The corrected construction plans for the open cockpit CORFET-150 will be ready for mailing in approximately 30 days, and orders will be filled in rotation as they are received. The prices shown are based upon an estimated volume of sales and subject to change without notice; so it is suggested that you place your order at an early date to be able to take advantage of present prices and early delivery.

Plans for the cabin model CORFET-150 will not be available for at least 60 days, as we are considering the possibility of designing the cabin into a two-place model if we find insufficient interest in a single-place cabin; therefore, we will welcome your suggestions if you are interested in building the cabin model.

Again we thank you for your valued inquiry and trust that we may help you to build your own plane through our years of combined experience.
